The global plastics and rubber industry is entering a period of sustained growth. The global plastics market is projected to exceed USD 2.1 trillion by 2029, growing at over 5.5% CAGR, while global rubber markets are expected to surpass USD 75 billion, reflecting continued demand across industrial and consumer applications.

Across the Middle East and North Africa, plastics manufacturing continues to accelerate. The regional plastics market is forecast to exceed USD 140 billion by 2029, driven by strong demand from packaging, construction, automotive, food & beverage, and healthcare, alongside increasing investment in processing capacity and modernisation.

Within this landscape, Egypt stands out as a key market. The country's plastics sector is expected to grow from USD 35.7 billion in 2024 to over USD 46 billion by 2029, accounting for nearly 11% of Middle East plastics consumption and reinforcing Egypt's role as a major production and demand centre.

As the industry shifts toward circularity, automation, and smarter manufacturing, PLASTEX 2028 sits at the centre of this transition connecting manufacturers, converters, and solution providers to support the next phase of plastics growth across Egypt and the wider MENA region.
